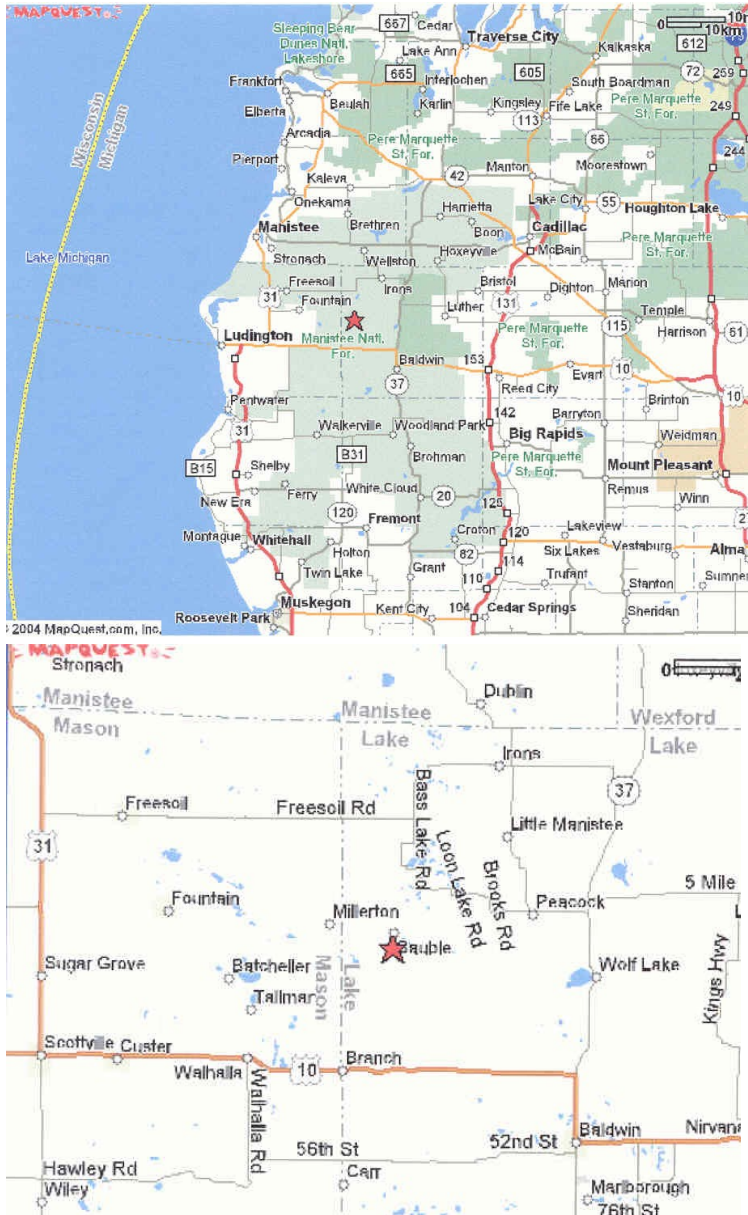

Twin Lakes Club was formed in 1927. The 720 acre, 12 member association property encloses 60 and 80 acre Twin Lakes. Cabins were built around the smaller of the two lakes so the larger could remain undisturbed.

Directions:

Go north from US10 at Branch, between Baldwin and Ludington. **Tyndall Road** is the only road north in Branch.

Tyndall winds east and then back to the north and becomes Hamilton Road. Approx. 7.2 miles north from US10 is the Twin Lakes Club mailbox & dirt road entrance to the property. Follow the road to cabin #4 and you should see canoes on cars. that is the right place.
